



2025 OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD SHOEBOX MINISTRY!

Weller will once again be participating in the annual Operation Christmas Child (OCC) Shoebox Ministry. This is a ministry we have been participating in for many years. Each year we send shoeboxes filled with gifts to children around the world. Not only do they receive the gifts in the box, but they have also the opportunity to learn about God and Jesus' love for them. The Weller OCC Team will prepack the individual shoeboxes for the children with the appropriate items based on gender and age. You may also purchase items and pack the boxes on your own, if you prefer to do so. However, please be aware there are numerous items that can not be included. The boxes are distributed to children in the following age groups: 2-4, 5-9, and 10-14. This may be one of the very few gifts they will ever receive.

The boxes will include:

School/Art supplies
Personal Hygiene Items
Four or five good quality toys/fun items
Some type of clothing (hats, socks, underwear, tee shirt, dresses)
A colorful Bible Story book in the child's native language.

Many of the children, depending on their location, will also have the opportunity to attend a 12 week Bible study class.

As the children are gathered in large groups and the boxes handed out, it is explained to them that this is a special gift from someone across the world who chose it just for them. Then, they are told of an even more precious gift; the gift of Jesus Christ.

If you would like to participate in this ministry, we ask you make a \$15.00 donation per box. Although the cost for filling and sending the boxes has increased, we are able to keep the \$15.00 per box donation that we have had for several years by supplementing with the proceeds of the yard sale. If you prefer to purchase items to pack boxes on your own, please be aware that there are several items that can not be included. A list of those items can be found on the Samaritan's purse website or you may check with me.

Upcoming Weller UMC Fall Yard Sale

Weather Permitting, Weller plans to have a yard sale on Wednesday, Oct. 8 AND Thursday, October 9, 2025, from 8:30 am – 3:00 pm to raise funds for the Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child Shoebox Ministry. This ministry is one of the largest projects that the Weller congregation participates in. The yard sale will be held at the Weller House, across the street from the Church. Items will be available in both the garage and the handicapped accessible basement of the Weller House. Most items will not be priced. We ask that a donation be made for these. We have, however, this year received a large donation of new candles from Bath and Body, as well as many new Rae Dunn mugs. Since these are brand new, they will be priced.

For those of you who are not familiar with this ministry, we pack shoeboxes for children ages 2-14 with school/art supplies, personal hygiene items, clothing, and fun/toy items. The boxes are shipped throughout the world to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ. Each child who receives a shoebox will also receive a colorful Bible Story book written in their native language. Most of the children, depending on where they live, are invited to participate in a 12-week Bible Study Class.

The proceeds of our yard sale will be used to help defray the costs involved for us to carry out this ministry. Last year, Weller was able to pack 215 shoeboxes. We are hoping to provide at least this amount again this year. Beginning October 19th, we will be asking those in the congregation who want to participate in this ministry to donate \$15.00 per box. With the rising costs of items, the \$15.00 does not cover the cost for the contents we include in the boxes, the cost of the colorful Bible Story Book, the 12-week Bible Study Class plus shipping fees. By using the yard sale money to supplement the costs, we can keep the \$15.00 per box donation that we have had in place for the last several years.
